

Assistant Professor position in solids mechanics

The Department of Mechanics at École polytechnique invites applications for a faculty position at the Assistant Professor level in solids mechanics, starting **September 1st, 2023**.

PhD holders, candidates must have demonstrated strong research and teaching capabilities. They must be able to contribute to the teaching of the Department of Mechanics at all levels of training (Bachelor's, Ingénieur polytechnicien program and Master's) and must be integrated into the teaching teams of the fundamental mechanics courses and the more specialized courses. Their ability to contribute to project-based teaching and to strengthen the links between teaching, research and applications will be an important element.

The selected candidate will be a member of the Laboratoire de Mécanique des Solides (LMS), where she/he will develop original research. Candidates should provide a complete curriculum as well as a short research project (maximum 2 pages) and a description of their teaching experience.

In terms of responsibilities, duties, and salary, Assistant Professor positions at École Polytechnique are equivalent to the French academic positions of “Maître de Conférences”.
